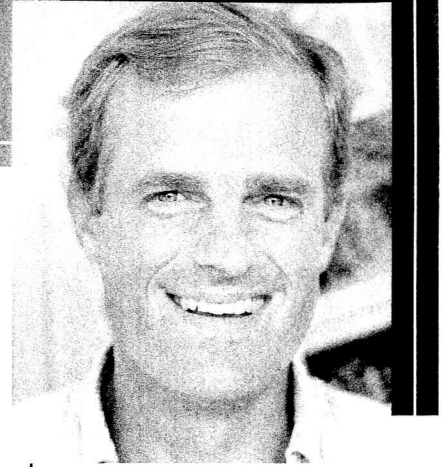


LESSON 4



Chapter 4:6-14

Jesus was tired from his long trip, so he sat down beside the well. It was about noon. ⁷A Samaritan woman came to the well to get some water, and Jesus said to her, "Please give me a drink." ⁸This happened while his followers were in town buying some food.

⁹The woman answered, "I am surprised that you ask me for a drink! You are a Jew and I am a Samaritan woman!" (Jews are not friends with Samaritans.)

¹⁰Jesus answered, "You don't know what God can give you. And you don't know who I am who asked you for a drink. If you knew, you would have asked me, and I would have given you living water."

¹¹The woman said, "Sir, where will you get that living water? The well is very deep, and you have nothing to get water with. ¹²Are you greater than *Jacob* our father? He is the one who gave us this well. He drank from it himself, and his sons and all his animals drank from it too."

¹³Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again. ¹⁴But anyone who drinks the water I give will never be thirsty again. The water I give people will be like a spring flowing inside them. It will bring them eternal life."
