## *Chapter 11:38-44*

<sup>38</sup>Again feeling very upset, Jesus came to the tomb. It was a cave with a large stone covering the entrance. <sup>39</sup>He said, "Move the stone away."

Martha said, "But Lord, it has been four days since Lazarus died. There will be a bad smell." Martha was the sister of the dead man.

<sup>40</sup>Then Jesus said to her, "Remember what I told you? I said that if you believed, you would see God's divine greatness. "

<sup>41</sup>So they moved the stone away from the entrance. Then Jesus looked up and said, "Father, I thank you that you heard me. <sup>42</sup>I know that you always hear me. But I said these things because of the people here around me. I want them to believe that you sent me." <sup>43</sup>After Jesus said this he called in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out!" <sup>44</sup>The dead man came out. His hands and feet were wrapped with pieces of cloth. He had a handkerchief covering his face.
